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NOTICE

The Tuolumne County Transit Agency ("TCTA") is seeking bids from qualified firms ("Contractor") to purchase and install a mobile trailer-mount, emergency standby generator for the Tuolumne County Transit Main office and maintenance facility located at 13033 Sanguinetti (loop) Road, Sonora with supporting electrical work. The payment of prevailing wages is required.

Prior to award of the contract, the Contractor shall possess a C10- Electrical Contractor's License issued by the State of California Contractor's Licensing Board. Failure of the bidder to obtain the required license before award of the contract constitutes a failure to execute the contract. For public works projects OVER twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) when the project is for construction, alteration, demolition, installation, or repair work or public works projects OVER fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) when the project is for maintenance work, the Contractor and any subcontractors shall be registered with the Department of Industrial Relations prior to bid. BACKGROUND

Tuolumne County is located in the center of the California Mother Lode area along the western slope of the Sierra Nevada mountain range. The County is bordered on the north by Calaveras County, on the south by Mariposa County, on the west by Stanislaus County and on the east by Alpine and Mono Counties. Sonora is the only incorporated city in Tuolumne County and is also the County seat. Tuolumne County Transit has funding through the California Office of Emergency Services to increase the safety and resiliency of the public transportation system. These funds can only be used for safety enhancements to public transit systems.

SELECTION PROCESS

Firms or individuals interested in bidding on this project should obtain an Invitation For Bids (IFB) packet which can be picked up at:

The IFB includes a description of the services to be provided, copies of the applicable agreement, and the bid form. Bids must be submitted by the due date below to be considered.

SECTION I – SCOPE OF WORK

The services to be rendered pursuant to this IFB consist, in general, of primarily the purchase and installation of a mobile trailer-mount, emergency standby generator for the Tuolumne County Transit Main office and maintenance facility located at 13033 Sanguinetti (loop) Road, Sonora with supporting electrical work consistent with Exhibit C (attached) Plans and Specifications. The Contractor shall carry out and include all investigations required at the site for the existing system prior to bid and shall include in the bid all components, devices, modifications or additions to the existing electrical systems required to produce the intended results. Permits for work will be provided by the Tuolumne County Transit Agency through the Tuolumne County Building Department. Work shall be completed prior to April 15, 2020.

Unit costs shown in Exhibit B, "Bid Form," of this IFB shall include full compensation for furnishing all labor, materials, tools, equipment, and incidentals, and for doing all the work as specified in this IFB.

The TCTA reserves the right to modify the scope of work, including the right to increase or decrease the quantity of any item or portion of the work, or to entirely delete any item or portion of any work, or to require extra work as deemed by the TCTA to be necessary or advisable. Any such changes will be set forth in a Contract Change Order, which will not become effective until approved by the TCTA.

For a period of one year after acceptance of the work, Contractor shall be responsible for the repair of all defects or failures occurring in the work which are, as determined by the TCTA, due to negligence in the manufacture and/or installation of the facility, exclusive of the operation of the facility by the TCTA or its agents, acts of third parties, acts of God, or acts of the common enemy.

SECTION II – COMPENSATION

Payment for services contemplated by this IFB shall be based on the unit prices submitted on Exhibit B – Bid Form of this IFB.

SECTION III – CONSTRUCTION

All work specified in this contract shall be done in accordance with Plans and Specification in Exhibit C.

SECTION IV – PRE-BID INFORMATION AND BIDDER'S QUESTIONS

A mandatory pre-bid meeting will be scheduled on Tuesday, January 14 at 10 am in the Tuolumne County Transit Main office and maintenance facility located at 13033 Sanguinetti (loop) Road, Sonora, California. Questions regarding this IFB must be submitted in writing to the TCTA by 5:00 p.m. on Thursday January 16, 2020. Except for questions that might render the award of this contract invalid, the TCTA will not respond to any questions submitted after this time. The TCTA will post the questions received, along with written responses, to the TCTC/TCTA website, www.tuolumnecountytransportationcouncil.org/, (click on "RFPs, RFQs and Organizational Documents" in the Resources Section). It is the responsibility of the bidders to check the TCTA website to review the questions and responses. Any oral responses to questions are not binding on the TCTA.

SECTION V – BID SUBMITTALS

Firms or individuals interested in performing the requested services should complete the following steps needed for a successful bid:

- D. Complete and submit the attached Exhibit B Bid Form.

Bidder's name and return address must also appear on the envelope. Bids may also be hand delivered to the Tuolumne County Transit Agency, 975 Morning Star Drive, Ste A, Sonora, California 95370.

Bids will be received only at the address shown above, and must be received by the time indicated. It is the sole responsibility of the bidder to send or deliver its bid so that it is received by the time and date required, regardless of postmark. Any bid received after said time and/or date or at a place other than the stated address, cannot be considered and will not be accepted. No e-mailed or facsimile bids will be considered. The Tuolumne County Transit Agency time stamp shall be considered the official timepiece for the purpose of establishing the actual receipt of bids.

Bids will be opened publicly at 1:10 p.m. on the bid due date in the conference room for the TCTA located at 975 Morning Star Drive, Ste A, Sonora, California 95370.

SECTION VII – AWARD OF CONTRACT

The award of the contract, if it is to be awarded, will be to the lowest responsible bidder whose bid complies with all the requirements prescribed. Such award, if made, will be made within sixty (60) days after the opening of the bids, unless an extension is agreed to by the lowest responsible bidder. The award of the contract will be subject to the availability of funds. The TCTA reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any irregularities in the bidding.

Contractors may not withdraw their bids for a period of sixty (60) days after the date on which the bids are due. The selected Contractor shall be required to sign the TCTA Agreement, a sample of which is attached to this IFB.

SECTION VIII – BONDS

A bidder's bond is not required. A payment bond is required for any public works contract in excess of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000).

SECTION IX - POLICY

TCTA will never exclude any person from participation in, deny any person the benefits of, or otherwise discriminate against anyone in connection with the award and performance of any contract on the basis of race, religion, creed, medical condition, color, marital status, ancestry, sex, age, national origin or disability. In addition, TCTA requires that any Contractor hired by TCTA to perform any work activity does not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment because of race, religion, creed, medical condition, color, marital status, ancestry, sex, age, national origin or disability.

The Contractor shall comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended accordingly.

SECTION X - GENERAL CONDITIONS FOR INVITATION FOR BIDS

1. Safety

Contractor shall comply with all applicable provisions of the California Occupational Safety and Health Act of 1973, including any amendments thereto, and the rules, standards, orders and regulations prescribed by the Occupational Safety and Health Standards Board and the Division of Industrial Safety of the California Department of Industrial Relations. Contractor shall further comply with all other applicable safety laws, ordinances and regulations. Contractor shall provide proof of compliance, if requested by the TCTA.

The TCTA shall have the right to prohibit the operation of equipment by specific operators, as necessary, to maintain safety.

2. Wage Rates

Pursuant to Section 1773 of the Labor Code, the general prevailing wage rates in the County in which the work is to be done have been determined by the Director of the California Department of Industrial Relations. These wages are set forth in the General Prevailing Wage Rates for these

services and available from the California Department of Industrial Relations' Internet web site at http://www.dir.ca.gov.

3. DIR Registration and Notice

For public works projects OVER twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) when the project is for construction, alteration, demolition, installation, or repair work or public works projects OVER fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) when the project is for maintenance work, the Contractor and any subcontractors shall be registered with the Department of Industrial Relations to be qualified to bid on, be listed in a bid proposal or engage in the performance of any public work contract subject to Labor Code section 1720. This project is for installation work. Please see http://www.dir.ca.gov/Public-Works/PublicWorks.html for more information. If applicable, no contract will be entered into without proof of the contractor's and subcontractors' current registration with the Department of Industrial Relations to perform public work. If awarded a contract, the bidder and its subcontractors, of any tier, shall maintain active registration with the Department of Industrial Relations for the duration of the Agreement.

These services are subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the Department of Industrial Relations. Each contractor and subcontractor must furnish certified payroll records to the Labor Commissioner at least monthly. It is the bidder's sole responsibility to evaluate and pay the cost of complying with all labor compliance requirements under this contract and applicable law.

The TCTA is required to provide notice to DIR of any public work contract subject to prevailing wages within thirty (30) days of the award. Upon notice, the TCTA will provide the DIR project number to the Contractor.

4. Public Record

All bids submitted in response to this request shall be deemed public record. If Contractor desires to claim portions of its bid exempt from disclosure, Contractor shall clearly identify those portions with the word "Confidential" printed on the lower right-hand corner of the page. TCTA will consider Contractor's request for exemption from disclosure; however, TCTA will make a decision based upon applicable laws. An assertion by Contractor that the entire bid, or a large portion of such, is exempt from disclosure will not be honored.

5. Addenda

Any addenda issued by the TCTA during the time of bidding or forming a part of the documents issued to the bidder for preparation of its bid, shall be covered in the bid and shall be a part of the contract. Receipt of all addenda shall be acknowledged on the bid form in the space provided therefor. It is the responsibility of the bidder to check the TCTA website for any addenda.
