3. Approval of purchasing one new bus, a Type C Glaval 16 + 2, in the amount of \$106,100.17, off the California Association of Coordinated Transit (CalACT) piggyback contract available to all CalACT members

This item is for the purchase of one cutaway bus for the Tuolumne County Transit fleet to replace an older bus that has met its useful life requirement. As identified in the attached Purchase Estimate, the cost of the new bus with associated option items is \$106,100.17.

This bus will be purchased through the California Association for Coordinated Transportation (CalACT) Cooperative Agreement, which has been approved by the FTA and Caltrans and meets the Federal requirements for buses purchases. The bus will include 16 seats for the general public, two wheelchair positions at the rear of the bus, and an optional two-person flip seat in one of the rear wheelchair positions, if additional seating is required.

Financial Impact:

The TCTA annually sets aside \$80,000 in Local Transportation Funds (LTF) annually for this specific purpose—purchase of new buses. We have ample funding in the approved budget to cover the cost of the bus. The quote does not include installation of bus wrap or radio equipment.
