Executive Director Grossi provided an update on the Stockton Road project. He stated that the City issued and RFP and received only one response. He added that they met today and this item is going before the City Council next month and they will be moving forward with it.

Councilmember Williams then thanked the TCTA for this project and the City for approving the project.

At this time, Executive Director Grossi provided a hand out regarding converting the bus fleet from fuel to electric. He informed Council Members that there is not a lot of produce in the smaller bus sizes and that the ones available are made in China – not the USA; and that this is a stipulation on receiving funding.
